Dear Sir:

I beg to quote hereunder the details of the deed for which the Military Medal was awarded your son #1393, Pte. Andrew Smith, Royal Newfoundland Regiment, taken from supplement to the London Gazette.

"For conspicuous gallantry and devotion to duty. On the 14th Oct. 1918 during the advance from LEDINGHEM towards the LYS, this man was acting as Company runner. During the whole of the day he repeatedly carried messages from the front line to En. H.Q. and back over ground swept by H.G. fire and by snipers. On one occasion when two runners had been sniped before they had gone 100 yards, Pte. Smith at once volunteered to take the message, and get it back to En. H.Q. Throughout the day he showed a complete disregard of danger."

Please accept my congratulations and assurance of the appreciation of the conduct of your son.
