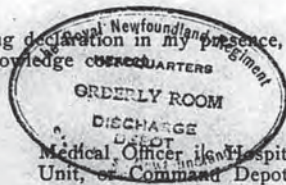

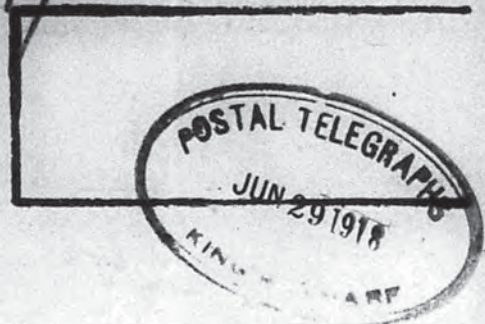

Dear Sir

I am writing you concerning
gratuity money which I earned & am entitled
to. The facts of my case are as follows.

During the years 1914 and 1918, I enlisted
three times here, but was turned down by
our local doctor, owing to weak ankles, who
told me it would be useless to go to St. John's
for examination, as I would not pass.

In 1918 finding my ankles much improved
I was again examined here, and the doctor
told me I would possibly pass. Hence on
April 25th I was given a pass by S. S. [unclear]
for St. John's. I was accepted there on May 1st
and started training. I was in training
at St. John's until Dec 11th when the
Regiment was being demobilized. I was then
discharged.

I was listed to go over-seas with
the July draft, but at the last moment the
medical board decided to hold me over until the next

draft. In September the same thing occurred.

In October I was promised that I would go over ~~for~~ with the next draft. But as you know, peace was declared in November and I did not get overseas.

So I considered that I am entitled to the same gratuity ^{as my credit} who enlisted when I did and went overseas, but did not see fighting received. As my not getting overseas was no fault of mine, as I was very anxious to get overseas, as can be testified by Capt Murphy or Capt Brady.

Hoping to receive this gratuity as soon as possible.
