I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your communication of 9th inst., with reference to the above soldier, and telegraphed you as per copy enclosed.

This man's medical report was sent in and went before the Medical Board, who confirmed same, and accordingly notice of August 15th was issued.

The man himself however, reported in person on August 20th, after the notice had been mailed, was examined by the Military Medical Officers and found fit for service, after which he was sworn in as a soldier for Active Service. The confusion in the matter is easily understood in view of the first notice sent him, but which was cancelled as above noted by the man in question coming in and being found fit.

When a man actually comes in and is sworn into the service, and is doing duty at the Barracks, this over-rides all other action taken, until he receives his final discharge from the Army.

# Descriptive Return of a Soldier Discharged on Account of Disability.

**INSTRUCTIONS**—This form is to be completed in the case of every discharged soldier whose claim to pension, on account of disability, is to be submitted for the consideration of the Pensions and Disabilities Board.

This section should be completed in the Hospital at which a man is attending at the time of his examination by a Medical Board, or, if the man is not in Hospital, by the Medical Officer of the Unit or Command Depot. The Soldier should be given a full opportunity of examining it, as, if awarded a pension, his subsequent identification, depends on his confirming this declaration. The "Rank," "Station" and "Date" should be in his own handwriting.
