Sir:-

I enclose telegram from Commissioner Mifflin, in connection with brother of Ephriam Stockley. I find that Ephriam Stockley was accepted and attested on June 4th under number 5596. It is evident that another eligible brother is claiming exemption on the grounds that he has a brother serving, Namely, Ephriam Stockley.

I shall be glad if you will lay this matter before the Judges for the interpretation of the Act and ruling thereof.

Under the Proclamation of May 11th all men covered by such Proclamation automatically became soldiers, and my reading of claim for exemption under B & C would be that any claims made on this account would have to be in connection with brothers who were or had been in the service previous to the date of the Proclamation, and that one man called up by the proclamation could not claim exemption on account of another brother called up by the proclamation and who did not report until the said proclamation had been issued. It would seem contrary to the spirit of the Act which required all men to register on or before May 24th, that an application for exemption should be made under Grounds B, as said soldier was not actually enlisted until June 4th, 1918.
