he have had 4 Birthdays in the army. you can
see by his number that he is one of the
Blue Birdies boys. now sir I am quite ignorant
of who I should apply to to get furlough
but seeing your name as minister of militia I
thought I may strike the right man. Please
do your best and ansure this note and put me on
the right track to obtain furlough for sergeant

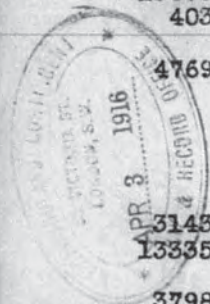
