Sir:-

I have the honour by direction, to reply to your communication of the 6th inst., relative to pension. If you have been reattested at Headquarters for special service, you will be entitled to draw the pay and allowance of your rank, namely, \$1.10 per day, in addition to which ninety cents per day is paid for board allowance, making a total of \$2.00 per day, equivalent to \$60.00 per month. A man cannot draw his pay as a soldier and at the same time receive his pension. Should you desire to give up this employment at any time, you would of course, be entitled to receive your pension again, or should you take up any position in civil life, it would not affect the pension, which would continue to be payable to you.

I trust this explanation will make the matter clear to you.

I beg to bring to your notice the fact that my Pension has been stopped. The reason I believe is because I have been employed as Billeting Clerk at Hdq's C.L.B. Armoury.

If this is so I fear there has been some mistake as the nature of my wound which is the loss of a leg entitles me to a life Pension, as I am unable to engage in my former trade on account of this disablement.

The decision of the Medical Board was \$16.00 per month for 12 months, and I think I am entitled to this for at least that length of time. If on account of my re-attestation I am to forfeit my Pension, I will have to be discharged, and some civil employment found me.

But I think if you will please give this matter your attention there will be no need of this.

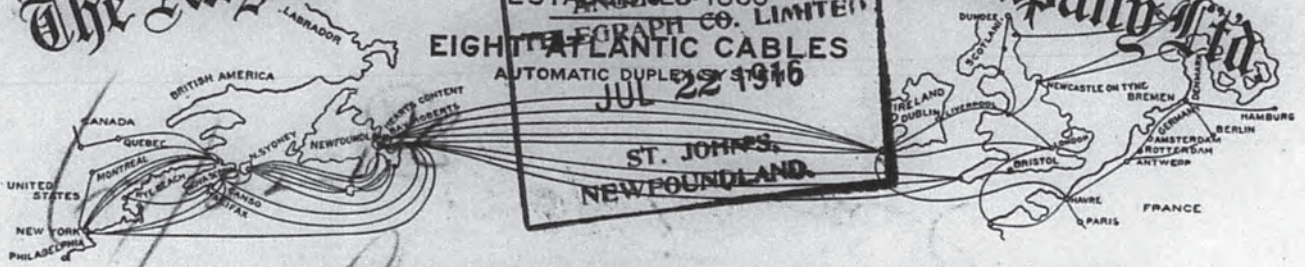
