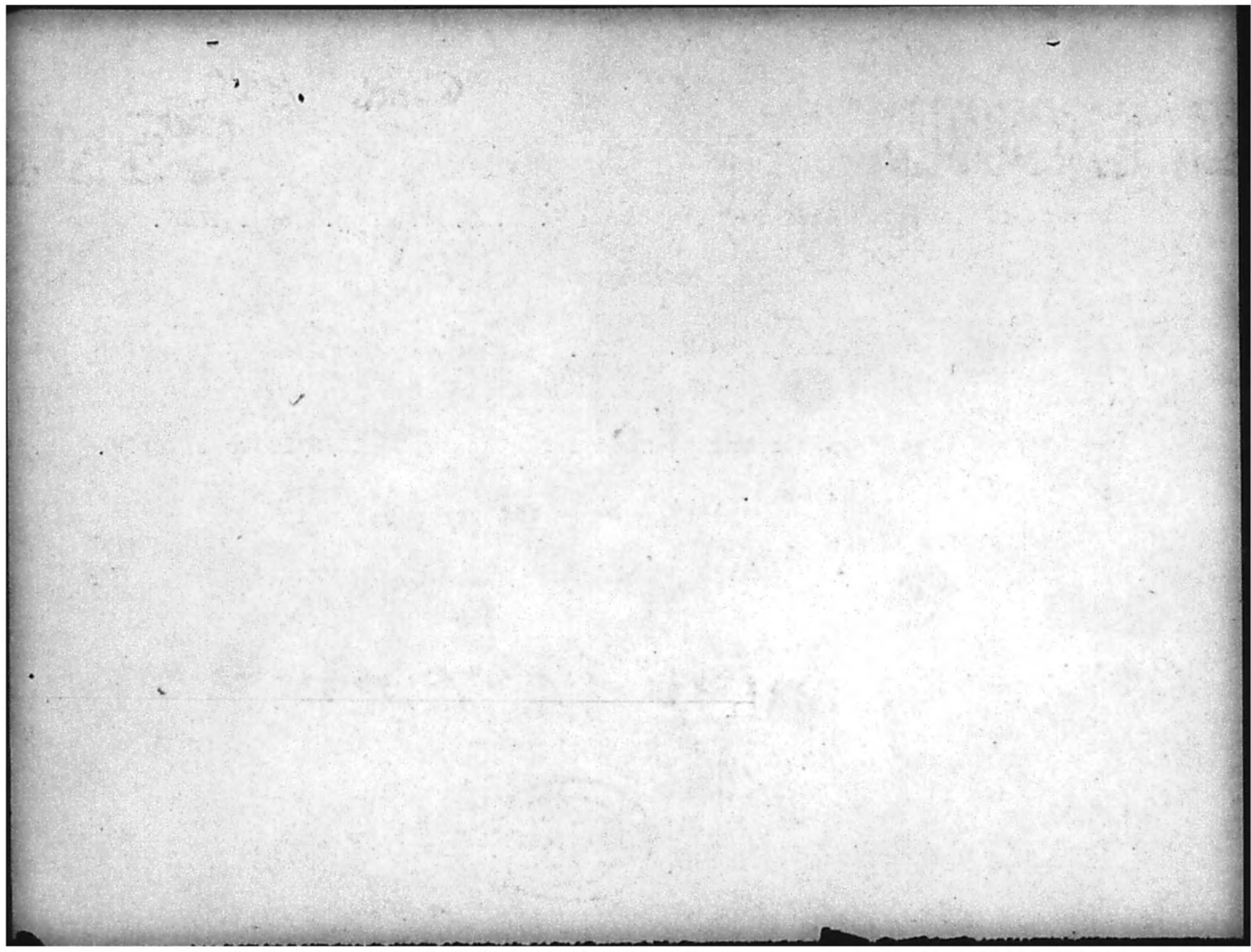

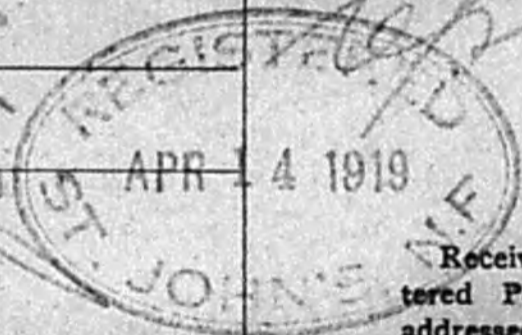

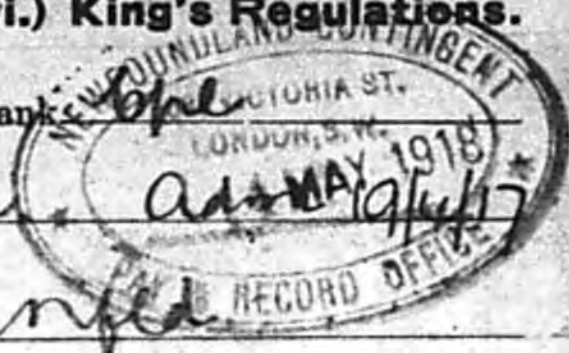

Opinion of the Medical Board.

Notes.—(i.) Clear and decisive answers to the following questions are to be carefully filled in by the Board, as, in the event of the man being invalided, it is essential that the Minister of Pensions should be in possession of the most reliable information to enable him to decide upon the man's claim to pension.

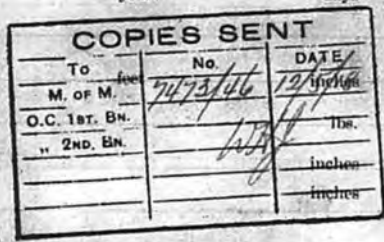

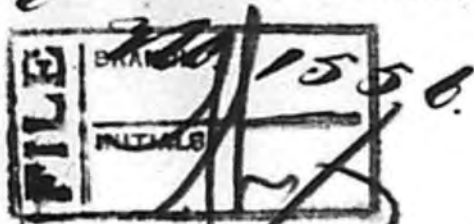

With reference to your letter of August 2nd, I beg to advise you that the following are the regulations governing the payment of War Service Gratuity.-

A man who has served less than one year in Newfoundland, and was not Overseas on Nov. 11/18 is entitled to 28 day's pay on discharge.

A man who served one year or over in Newfoundland, and was not Overseas on Nov. 11/18, is entitled to one month's War Service Gratuity \$70.00.

A man who served less than one year and was Overseas on Nov. 11/18 is entitled to 3 month's War Service Gratuity.

A man who served over one year, but less than two and was at the Front or Overseas on Nov. 11/18 is entitled to 4 month's War Service Gratuity.

A man who served two years but less than 3, as per the preceding is entitled to 5 month's W.S.G., and a man who served 3 years or over as per above, is entitled to 6 month's War Service Gratuity.
