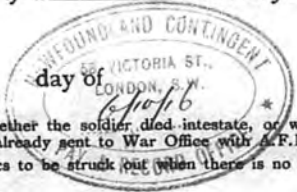

I beg to make application to you for extra pay for the hours I put in when a Medical Board is held.

There is one thing I must say, my general health is not up to much at present, and I have presented myself on several occasions to make it convenient for the "Board"

You all know that \$1.10 a day is small pay and I have been drawing that amount for three years, so I think personally that I should get extra pay for overtime. I am making it inconvenient for myself by doing this when I could be at home spending this waste time in study so as to make myself fit for a position in some future time.

If it was the case that I was discharged I could not go back at my former trade "Fishing" because I am disabled in left arm, of which you all know, so I think this should be taken into consideration.

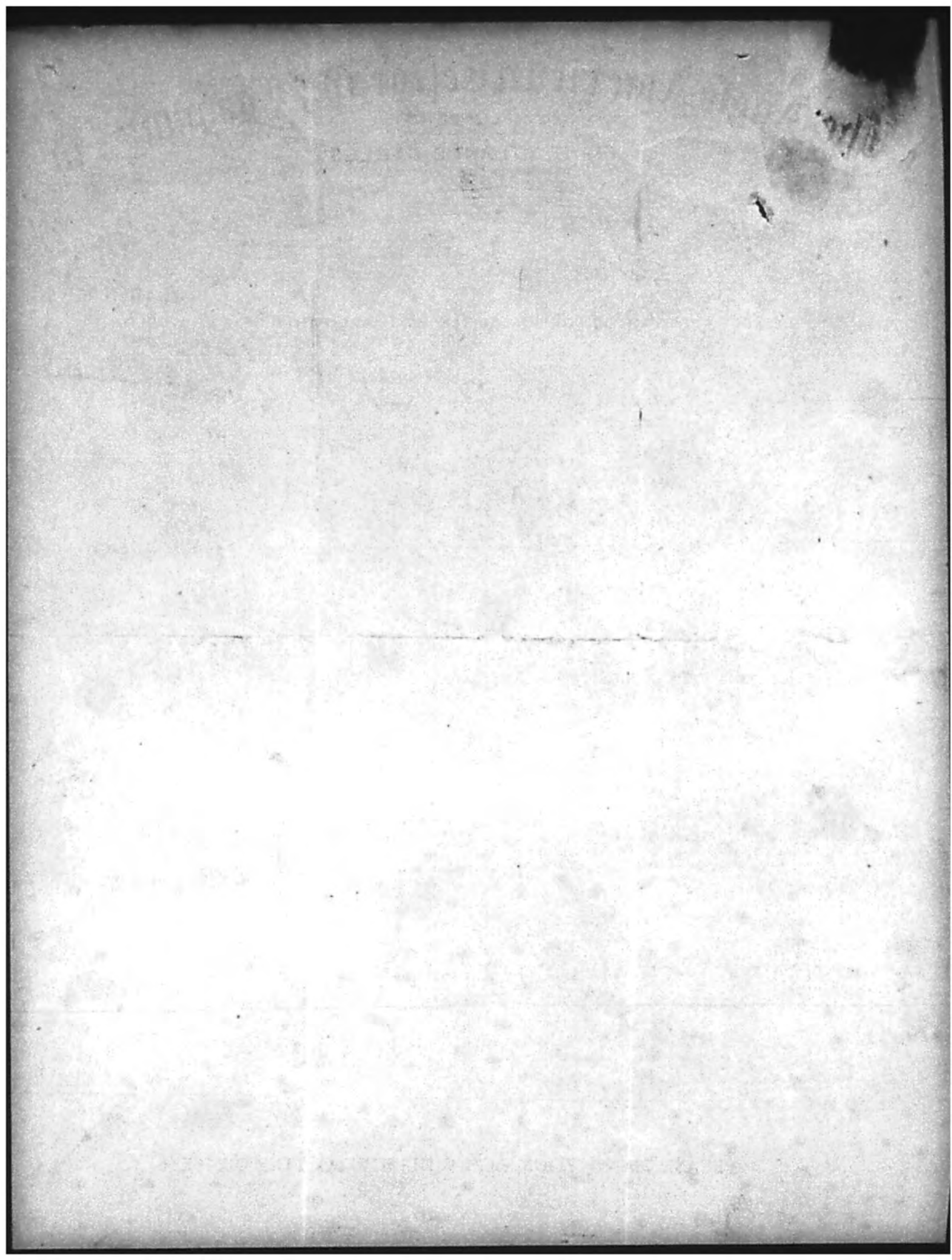

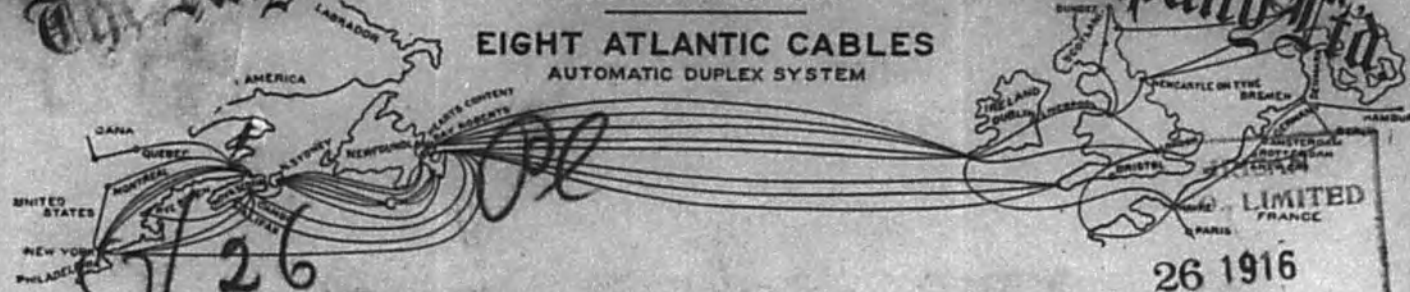
