The above named soldiers have reported back to barracks after an absence of about 5 months and in defence of the charge of "being absent without leave" state that when they were granted Home Leave at the beginning of June they were both taken very ill and have not been able to proceed to St. John's since that date until now.

They both state that they were under your care suffering from Bronchial Pneumonia. Pte. Withorne suffering from this complaint, after measles. Will you kindly state the facts of these cases in order that I may deal with them as circumstances require.

If their statements are genuine and they were really ill and could not proceed, of course, they will be free from any consequences. But, on the other hand, if this long absence without leave cannot be justified, then they will have to be dealt with accordingly.
